Cat and Dog Theology: Lesson 8 Outline:

One Sentence Summary: God has great pleasure in what He created in heaven and on earth.

A. Outline

- a. Introduction
 - i. Bob tells a story about building a desk. He loved being creative designing the desk and it brought him joy.
 - ii. God must have had great joy in making creation.
- b. Body
 - i. Bob says most evangelicals don't get excited about the Bible until Genesis chapter 3 because mankind sins and we have something to live for; to rescue people from hell. We non-verbally communicate that the Bible is really all about us.
 - ii. Colossians 1:16 says, "All things were created by Him and for Him.
 - 1. Cats miss this point. Cats ask "What do I get?"
 - 2. Dogs know that all things were created for God: everything, the stars, clouds, grass, fish, mountains... everything. Dogs ask "What does God get out of creation?"
 - iii. God thought of all kinds of questions before he created such as:
 - 1. Will things be purely spiritual or will they be material?
 - 2. Will all things be alike or different? Should they be big or small, liquid or solid, light or dark, etc.? God must have had a blast thinking up all these questions and many more.
 - 3. God created the heavens and the earth, so one of His decisions was to think big such as:
 - a. Our sun is one star in the Milky Way galaxy. The next nearest star to us is 4.2 light years away...
 - b. Our galaxy contains at least 200 billion stars and is 100, 000 light years in diameter.
 - c. There are between 200-300 billion galaxies.
 - 4. God also created small things such as
 - a. 90-99% of the universe is hydrogen and it is made up of atoms. Atoms are 0.000000001 meters across (one billion of a meter)
 - b. A hydrogen atom is made up of a proton and electron and a proton is 1/one hundredth of an atom and an electron is 1/one hundred millionth of an atom. This is very small.
 - iv. God, wanting to show off His glory, thought both big and small. God also enjoys seeing His creativity. Everything was created for Him, not for us.
 - v. In Genesis 1:9-10, God created the dry land and the seas, with great joy.
 - 1. Oceans occupy nearly 71% of our planet's surface.
 - 2. More than 97% of all our planet's water is contained in the ocean.
 - 3. The oceans provide 99% of the Earth's living space and less than 10 % of this living space has been explored by humans.
 - 4. In one small drop of water, there are thousands of small creatures called Paramecium. They have 20 different sex types and multiply every 3 hours.
 - vi. In Genesis 1:20, God created living creatures in the water. What fun He must have had creating and coloring the fish.

- 1. God had fun creating jelly fish, sea horses that have the male carry the babies,
- vii. God created many animals, trees, and creatures of intricate designs and with joy and they are all to His glory.
- viii. God's glory has been put on display all around us and God is having a blast watching it all perform exactly as He designed it.
- ix. Psalm 104:31 says, "May the glory of the Lord continue forever! The Lord takes pleasure in all He has made.."

- i. The Lord takes pleasure in all He has made. That is why at the end of each day in creation he said, "It is very good."
- ii. We too can have joy in the works of God's hands.
