- 1. We don't pray very much.
 - i. Average Christian prays 3 minutes a day. Why?
 - 1. Too busy- not enough time.
 - 1. James 4.2, "You do not have, because you do not ask God.
 - 2. Our needs are met.
 - 1. Most Americans are self-sufficient and can get their physical needs met.
- 2. We pray selfish prayers.
 - i. 3 kinds of petition and intercession prayers.
 - 1. Prayers for self
 - 2. Prayers for others
 - 3. Prayers for the kingdom of God
 - ii. Selfish Prayers
 - 1. We ask with wrong motives, esp. things for our pleasure.
 - 2. We respond to the old nature in us.
 - 1. Old nature: the natural person inside of us without Christ. It is the sinful nature
 - 2. New nature: That part of us that is born again.
 - 3. Gal. 5.24 & Col 3.5
 - 4. The old nature controlled us. But now the new nature that is united with the Holy Spirit can control us.
 - iii. Our new nature wants to pray for things for God's glory.
 - 1. Which nature are we feeding?
 - 2. God says no to selfish prayers.
